
# CHRISTMAS EVE LOVEFEAST AND CANDLELIGHT SERVICE Sunday, December 19 - 7:00 P.M.

Please join us on Sunday, December 19 at 7pm for the Christmas Eve Lovefeast and Candlelight Service.


