BOARD MEETING MINUTES

Covenant Moravian Church Board Meeting Minutes for 5/19/2021 at 7:00pm

Board Members present: Pastor Jeff Jones, Vice Chair Sheri Holland, Priscilla Donathan, Kathy Britt, Deb Elam, Judy Atkinson and Patricia Staton. **Not present**: Lori Bartels and Devon Baldwin.

Pastor Jeff called the meeting to order with the Daily Text Devotion and prayer.

Motion made to approve Agenda by Deb Elam/2nd Sheri Holland, all in favor.

It was noted that March board minutes were approved through emails and no board meeting was held for April.

Old Business: none

New Business:

- 1- Learning Bridge owners have requested a reduction of rent for Choir room class for the month of June and July. Current rent is 600.00/ month. After discussion, a motion was made by Deb Elam to grant a 200.00/month reduction for both months. Sheri Holland 2nd, all in favor. Pastor Jeff will contact Learning Bridge to relay this to them.
- 2-Kathy Britt informed the board that part of the new 5-year lease contract with Learning Bridge included Learning Bridge getting a separate water meter installed for the 2 school buildings. Crystal spoke with Frank Styers at Cape Fear Water Authorities. Frank said CFWA will not install an additional water meter so it would need to be installed by a private company. Kathy said a revised lease may be needed to address this issue. It was suggested to table until next month and we contact LB re: this issue.
- 3- HVAC quotes from 2 local companies were presented by Pastor Jeff, both quotes were close, after discussion Judy Atkinson made a motion to go with Anderson Air for replacing fellowship hall unit for \$8185.00 and \$823.00 to repair a sanctuary unit that has a leak. Anderson Air is the same company that services our current HVACs. Sheri Holland 2nd, all in favor.
- 4- Tony who cleans and waxes our floors has asked to consider him for cleaning the church on a regular basis. No price was given, Pastor Jeff will contact him regarding frequency/price/ details and get back to the board hopefully next month. It was suggested maybe 2x/month for frequency. Sheri Holland was recognized and thanked for all her work these past years. Covid has kept many at home and unable to do all that needs done.
- 5- Kathy Britt announced that her husband Don Britt wants to retire as our main Adult Sunday School teacher after 35+ years. We hope to have someone that will step up to the plate to teach starting in September.
- 6- Fundraising- Pastor Jeff asked that we look to having a more accountable and clear fundraising projects in the future.

Pastor report was held until after Ministry Team reports.

Options were discussed for Candle Tea on Saturday December 4th. Pastor Jeff would like to have a children's lovefeast service at the closing of our Candle Tea that afternoon. It was suggested that we begin planning soon with a committee to be able to get things like advertising and crafts started early.

Danny Donathan repaired our floor buffer by replacing some of the broken and worn-out wheels. He also fixed one of the fellowship hall women's room toilets.

Danny Donathan has given an estimate to replace the back building roof for\$9450.00 including materials/labor and removal of old roof and disposal of old roofing. It was discussed that this roof needed to be replaced hopefully before hurricane season.

Danny Donathan reports there is some extra material left over from recent new deck. He would like to use to repairs back steps of school building that is closest to picnic pavilion. Board was definitely ok with that.

Deb Elam made a motion that we proceed with the replacement of the roof, Judy Atkinson 2nd, all in favor. Pastor Jeff reports we may have a rodent problem in the church, an exterminator will be called asap.

Kathy reports having call members who have been ill or in a facility. She is checking to see if anyone needs meals and will let us know. She has spoken with Irene Freeman, Lib Schultz, Lynn her daughter and has made contact with Lou Motsinger also.
